



2013 Pinot Noir Reserve

Noble Ridge is an estate vineyard and winery located in the Okanagan Valley. All work is done by hand on site by a team of dedicated workers who strive to create exceptional wine that reflects its noble namesake.

TASTING NOTES

This Pinot Noir exhibits a deep ruby color and complex nose featuring bright red fruit aromas of strawberry and cherry. The palate follows with ripe red fruit, subtle vanilla and anise with a touch of earthiness. A wine in harmonious balance, the structure and intensity indicate a Pinot Noir of such quality that it will age gracefully for another 5 to 6 years.

FOOD PAIRING

Barbecued pork tenderloin, brisket, ribs, grilled Portobello mushroom

WINEMAKING

De-stemmed, crushed and cold soaked for 5 days, then fermented between 22 and 25 degree Celsius. The wine spent 12 months in 100% French oak barrels (20% new oak)

HARVEST

Sourced entirely from Noble Ridge Vineyard in Okanagan Falls. All hand-picked.
