Noble Ridge is an estate vineyard and winery located in the Okanagan Valley. All work is done by hand on site by a team of dedicated workers who strive to create exceptional wine that reflects its noble namesake.

TASTING NOTES

Our Pinot Noir is characterized by a strong ruby colour, not common in Pinot Noir. Wonderful fruit aroma and earthy, plummy flavours combine with delicate yet distinct structure and complexity in this Pinot Noir. Hints of spice and cherry and black currants, anise and vanilla. It has beautiful mouth feel with soft, silky tannins and a long finish.

Roasted pork; poultry
Grilled duck breast
Mushroom dishes
Full bodied fish dishes

WINEMAKING

Cold soak; whole cluster pressed
Cool fermentation in stainless steel tanks
12 months in 100% French Oak
Bottle aged for 24 months
All fractions kept separate until bottling, then blended

Sourced entirely from Noble Ridge Vineyard in Okanagan Falls.
All hand picked.
