Noble Ridge is an estate vineyard and winery located in the Okanagan Valley. All work is done by hand, on-site by a team of dedicated workers who strive to create exceptional wine that reflects its noble namesake.

TASTING NOTES

This full-flavored, full bodied Cabernet Sauvignon offers rich aromas of dark cocoa, coffee and dark fruit. Ripe flavors of blueberry and black cherry are highlighted with hints of black pepper, vanilla with a touch of spice. Smooth, yet firm tannins lend to a velvety, lingering finish!

FOOD PAIRING

Best paired with big proteins, rib-eye steak, lamb chops and BBQ ribs

WINEMAKING

De-stemmed and crushed
Cold soaked for 3 days and fermented between 25-28 degrees Celsius. The juice then spent 16 months in a combination of 66% French Oak and 33% American Oak. 33% new barrels, all fractions kept separately and then blended.

HARVEST

All grapes are sourced from Noble Ridge Vineyards.
