WINEMAKING

De-stemmed and crushed.
Cold soaked for 3 days
Fermentation kept between 25 °C and
28 °C, 12 months in barrel, 75% French,
25% American; 20% new oak.

Tasting Notes

Rich and generous with lifted Black
Current and Brambleberry. Accents of
Cedar and Dried Cocoa with lingering
notes of herb and graphite.
